I interviewed DOUGLAS BAYER inside the second floor interview room at the Monroe Post on 4/8/05 at approximately 10:00AM.

The interview was video taped. (Video tape attached. See *Manufactured Evidence* heading.)

Summary

- DOUGLAS BAYER is currently employed as an emergency medical technician with the Detroit Fire Department. He has been employed by DFD since 1999.
- From 1991 to 1996, BAYER was a non-certified part-time officer with the Inkster Police Department.
- As a Detroit FD EMT, BAYER is normally assigned to a medic unit. Each medic unit has an assigned area to cover; however, depending on availability, any Detroit City medical unit can respond anywhere in the city.
- BAYER advised it was not unusual for injured victims to refuse medical treatment before or during transport.
- BAYER is a competitive pistol shooter, and currently shoots at the "Top Gun" range in Taylor, Michigan. He used to shoot at the "Wolverine Gun Club" on Dix Road in Brownstown Township.
- BAYER has never picked up any injured female for any reason at the Manoogian Mansion during KWAME KILPATRICK's administration.
- BAYER has never treated any female victim who told him she was beat up by Mayor KILPATRICK's wife.
- BAYER said approximately 3 years ago, during the fall of 2002 (October/November) when he was working Medic Unit #6 or #8 at approximately 10:00PM-11:00PM (during the hours of darkness), he arrived at Detroit Receiving Hospital where he observed a large crowd in the reception area who were causing a

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commotion. BAYER was told the commotion occurred because "the Mayor's wife had beat down some bitch."

- BAYER did not see/identify the involved victim.
- BAYER said the crowd causing the commotion consisted of approximately 20-25 people; i.e. white people, black people, males & females. Some of the people were well-dressed, and 2 individuals had Secret Service type ear pieces.
- BAYER did not recognize any Detroit Police officers in the crowd. BAYER assumed the well-dressed "pimped out" individuals with the ear pieces were DPD Executive Protection officers.
- BAYER traveled to Detroit Receiving Hospital on the night in question to drop off an unknown victim with an unknown injury. BAYER said he used a wheelchair to carry the victim to the reception area. (NFI)
- On the night in question, BAYER approached the crowd/commotion pushing his patient in a wheelchair. As he neared the crowd, a black male with a shaved bald head (thin build, approximately 5'9" with medium complexion, no facial hair, wearing a shirt, tie & jacket and a Secret Service type ear piece) directed the people in the crowd to cleared a path for BAYER and his patient. BAYER then left his patient and walked out of the reception area.
- As BAYER exited the hospital, he asked a group of emergency medical technicians (approximately 6-8 people) what the commotion was about. BAYER believed Detroit FD Paramedic CEBINO CHAPA (white male, short, 300#, aka:Snowman) responded by saying, "Apparently the Mayor's wife just beat down some bitch."
- BAYER did not know who transported the woman who was "beat down" to Detroit Receiving Hospital.
- After DFD Paramedic CHAPA told him about the apparent beating, BAYER sat on a half-wall outside the reception area and watched the crowd/commotion with the rest of the EMT's. BAYER said additional well-dressed individuals arrived at the scene. (NFI)
- BAYER called his brother, DONALD BAYER, using his cell phone and told DONALD about the apparent beating just before he (DOUGLAS) left Detroit Receiving Hospital.
- BAYER said when he drove his ambulance to Detroit Receiving Hospital on the night in question, he almost ran into a large black SUV, possibly a Navigator parked in the "angle" parking area. BAYER explained that "angle" parking at Detroit Receiving Hospital is reserved for non-emergency ambulances & police officers.

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- In the Fall of 2002, BAYER's regular partners were KATRINA BAILEY-Medic 8, JIM TORRES-Medic 6, and KEN McKAY-Medic 6. BAYER believed EMT JOE ACQUINO was Paramedic CHAPA's partner on the night in question.
- BAYER advised he did not come forward with the information because he believed it was hearsay and due to the fact that Attorney General COX said there was no party at the Mansion shortly after the investigation began.
